

6th grade Supply List

- Pencil bag or box*, to carry to each class, that contains the following:
 - Pencils*** (10 regular or mechanical with extra lead)
 - Pens* (3 standard black or blue, and 3 red for checking)
 - Highlighter pens of choice
 - Note cards* (3 x 5, 50 count. Remainder of package can stay at home or locker)
 - 6" ruler* for use in Math class (or 12" if it fits in pencil bag)
- White loose-leaf notebook paper***
- One 2-pocket folder* as the homework & communication folder (sturdy, 12" x 9" or larger, design of your choice)
- Five-tab dividers (6 sets, one for each subject binder) *
- One 1-inch three-ring binder for Math subject*
- Five ½ inch three-ring binders (For 5 subjects other than Math)* (½-inch due to limited locker space)
- Graph paper* (25-50 pieces)
- Composition Notebook (hard-bound type)
- Colored pencils (box of 8 or 12) to be stored in locker (or pencil box)
- Two family-size boxes of tissues (to be given to homeroom teacher)
- One container of Clorox™-style wipes (to be given to homeroom teacher)
- 12" ruler with centimeters and inches to be stored at home for math homework

*Bring to school on FIRST DAY of class.

Items in **bold type** are consumed rapidly. Please check on a weekly basis to insure that your child has a proper stock these items. Failure to have the required items can result in classroom consequences throughout the year. Other items (i.e., poster board, craft materials, etc) are needed periodically. Instructions will be given at appropriate times.

The traditional "everything binder" (three-ring binder with zipper) is no longer on the supply list and is now optional for students. Instead, a "Homework Folder" is requested that will serve to go home with your child every day.

Please do NOT purchase Sharpies or other permanent markers, non-CCHS supplied combination locks, or rubber bands.
