

Ski Club Parent Information Meeting 2018

Ski Club continues to be one of our most popular extracurricular activities.

CCHS Ski Club **Contracts** and **WinterPlace Rental Release Agreement Forms** are available in the office.

Cost: \$275/\$350 (if renting a snowboard): lift tickets, rentals and transportation for 5 weeks.

Chaperoned by Middle School and High School teachers.

Five Wednesdays in January and February, beginning January 10. Board busses at **3:20**, depart at **3:30** (we cannot wait for anyone), arrive by **5:00**. Passes are distributed at Winterplace; equipment rented; back on bus by **9:00pm**

Two busses are projected – Middle School & High School. Students are not allowed to board busses until the chaperone grants permission.

A School Sponsored Activity – all appropriate school rules apply. Ski Club Contract and Student Agreements are to be signed by participants and submitted to the office. (Review Contract)

Appropriate Clothing – layers; colder at Winterplace than Charleston (we hope), especially as night goes on. Goggles, waterproof pants, gloves, hat. Snow making equipment is often in use. **Helmets are encouraged and included with rental.**

If skis or snowboard need to be brought to school in the morning, they are to be **left in the stands** in the gym in the seats toward the river.

Personal items (book bags, uniforms, etc.) **can be left on the bus** at Winterplace but we will have no access to bus. Do not leave things unattended at Winterplace. **Things not locked up have been stolen** (clothing, book bags, skis). Neither Winterplace nor CCHS is responsible for stolen items. \$1 in quarters is needed each time a locker is opened.

Food is expensive – students can bring their own.

Lessons begin at 6pm in front of the lodge at the ski school sign – new skiers encouraged.

Deluxe lift passes for snowboards are required *if you are renting* (This is to be noted on the ski club application for an additional cost.) If the student paid for a snowboard rental, he/she needs to tell the chaperone when passes are distributed.

Ski with a friend. Students should not ski by themselves for safety reasons.

Back on bus by **9pm**. Passes will be held for late arrivals.

Rides home need to be at Sacred Heart before 10:30. Passes will be held if parents are late. Do not to park in front of the church - buses will block you in. Park in the faculty parking lot or on the left side of the street.

Must be in school **ON Time** the morning after ski club. Passes will be held.

If school is canceled on ski club days, we may still go skiing. Decision will be posted on the CCHS web site and the CCHS twitter. Students are responsible to check for themselves.

Regardless of the weather on Wednesdays, assume we will be going. We will make a decision by 11:00am on Wednesdays if the weather if questionable. It is hard for us to cancel with Winterplace and the buses.
