

December Dress Down Days 2022

Tuesday December 13: We will be having our ugly/ tacky holiday/ Christmas sweater day. Tops must be primarily red or green or have a holiday theme. Students may wear jeans or casual slacks of appropriate modest fit. Pants should not have rips or holes. Athletic shoes, sandals, boots, and clogs are acceptable. **Midriffs must be covered.**

No dresses, skirts, shorts, **leggings**, sweatpants, athletic pants, or pajama/lounge pants may be worn.

Flip-flops or Athletic Slides may **NOT** be worn.

Wednesday, December 14^h – Friday, December 16th

During exam dress down days, students will follow the casual dress guidelines in the student handbook.

Pants must not be torn/cut-off, frayed, ripped, or have holes.

All clothing must have modest coverage – midriffs and torsos should be covered; clothing should not be revealing.
